The day will start out in Ian’s paddocks to see and hear about the many pasture options he has introduced into his mixed farming system. These include Balansa clover on heavy soils, Yellow Serradella on light soils, and Anameka saltbush on saline soils.

He will be joined by Chris Poole from ALOSCA (nitrogen fixation in legumes), Geoff Moore from DPIRD (new Panic varieties), Angelo Loi from DPIRD (weed control in Serradella), Phil Barrett-Lennard from agVivo (soil pH and pastures) and Hayley Norman from CSIRO (Anameka Saltbush).

After the farm tour, we will drive to Moora for lunch and the afternoon session.
